



Understanding what your Aussiedoodle is!

Here is an explanation of the terminology so you can understand the numbers and letters that make up an Aussiedoodle generation. Included below we will explain what “F1B Aussiedoodle” means.

What does the “F” stand for?

In the name “F1B Aussiedoodle” the F means Filial Hybrid, this just means that he or she is a hybrid dog. All Aussiedoodle generations will begin with the letter F because they are not purebred dogs, they are a crossbreed between the Australian Shepherd and Poodle.

What does the number stand for?

The 1 in “F1B” pertains to the generation that the dog is. In our case, the number means that it is a first-generation Aussiedoodle. This conveys that the dog is of decent between Australian Shepherd and a Poodle.

What does the “B” stand for?

The B stands for Backcross. **Backcross** is a complex term that means that a mixed breed is bred with a **purebred dog** (either a 100% Australian Shepherd or a 100% Poodle). In our case at TC Aussiedoodles, the F1B Aussiedoodle is bred to a 100% Poodle, ***because they are allergy-friendly and don’t shed fur.***

Here is a quick reference guide showing a more in-depth summary of genetic make-up of each Aussiedoodle Generation as they are bred in many different combinations for certain specific features.

F1 Aussiedoodle: 50% Poodle & 50% Australian Shepherd

F1B Aussiedoodle: 75% Poodle & 25% Australian Shepherd

F1BB Aussiedoodle: 87.5% Poodle & 12.5% Australian Shepherd

F2 Aussiedoodle: 50% Poodle & 50% Australian Shepherd

F2B Aussiedoodle: 62.5% Poodle & 37.5% Australian Shepherd

F2BB Aussiedoodle: 81.25% Poodle & 18.75% Australian Shepherd

F3 Aussiedoodle or Multi-generation Aussiedoodle: Several generations of Aussiedoodle breeding usually backcrossed with the Poodle.

Tip: Pet owners almost always prefer Aussiedoodles that have more Poodle genetics.

Aussiedoodles are usually backcross bred to the Poodle for the hypoallergenic and non-shedding genes. However, it should be noted that there are some specific cases where a breeder may be backcross breeding with a purebred Australian Shepherd in which case an F1B Aussiedoodle will be 25% Poodle and 75% Australian Shepherd. However, these cases are very unlikely.

Aussiedoodle Personality & Temperament

The Aussie-doodle is super smart and easy to train. They will have basic training to go outdoors, be family, and accomplish small commands with the word "Treat" because of how we raised them. You should provide them additional training as soon as you bring them home so they may get accustomed to your daily routines.

Besides that, they are extremely loyal and love bonding with their humans! The Aussiedoodle is not an aggressive breed. They get along very well with children and other pets. However, if left alone for too long, they can become hyperactive or destructive, as any type dog would. Most breeders would recommend that you only get an Aussiedoodle if one of the family members can spend most of the day with them, this is not necessarily true, most dogs thrive on the rest they achieve during the daytime because dogs generally sleep more than humans. On the other hand, they like lots of exercise, playtime, interaction, and attention which you can make-up for by taking them for nice walks.

Another thing to keep in mind: Think about the size of your living space. This will be a big factor in their well-being. Typically, the bigger the dog, the more space it requires. In general, they are a small sized dog with a slim, yet surprisingly strong body, and they love room to run and play. The most ideal situation would be a house fed dog with a fenced-in yard where your Aussiedoodle can run around and play.

Health & Life Expectancy

The usual life expectancy of an Aussiedoodle is around 13-15 years. If you are lucky, they may be with you for longer. They are generally one of the healthiest dog types. Nevertheless, there are some genetic diseases which are unlikely, but they may inherit. These include Cushing's Disease, Cranial Cruciate, Ligament Rupture, Hip Dysplasia, Cataracts, Epilepsy, Pancreatitis, Ivermectin Sensitivity and Progressive Retinal Atrophy. However, to prevent this, we do thorough background checks with the Mother's and Father's to understand what we produce will not carry these poor genetics. They mothers and fathers are both happy healthy dogs with no ailments.

HEALTH GUARANTEE: As soon as your furever friend comes home, he or she is a part of the family. If a pet health issue arises, you should treat it with just as much care and concern as you would for any other member of the family. We are dedicated to matching you with happy and healthy dogs which is why our puppy health guarantee is so important to us. This covers what to do if you notice something amiss and what your rights are when you purchase through us. Ultimately, our dog health guarantee is in place to take care of our dogs and to let you feel completely comfortable when searching for your perfect match.

What We Guarantee You

What to expect from the Breeder:

- The breeder is required to sign and provide the contract.
- The breeder shall provide you with a puppy health record explaining what shots the puppy has had at the time of sale.
- The breeder shall also provide you with a puppy health certificate defining the veterinarian examination which was conducted prior to the time of sale. Any comments/defects found by the veterinarian shall be clearly explained to the purchaser with no hidden exemptions.
- To preserve your rights to the dog's health guarantee, you must take your newly purchased dog to a licensed veterinarian of your choice for examination within 10 days of purchase. If a veterinarian determines, within 10 days of purchase, that your dog is clinically ill or has died from an injury

sustained or illness likely to have been contracted on or before the date of sale and delivery, you have the following options:

1. Return the dog for a complete refund.
2. Return the dog for a replacement dog of equal value.
3. Retain the dog and receive reimbursement for the veterinarian fees to make the puppy healthy, not to exceed 50% of the original purchase price.

Coating, Shedding, and Hypoallergenic Level

Aussiedoodles usually have a non-shedding, hypo-allergenic coat, which we call “fur-coating” with varying colors and curliness but sweetly soft to the touch. The curliness or waviness truly depends on how much they inherit from each parent, some will carry more specific traits than other. The aussiedoodle F1B are more hypoallergenic than their Aussiedoodle Mother due to the natural genes inherited from the Poodle Father. So if you have pet dander allergies, you are in the right place.

Shipping and Payment Mode

SHIPPING: We ship puppies by Delta Courier service after they are 8 weeks old. Airlines will restrict shipping until puppies are 8 weeks old by rule. The airline is very experienced in animal shipping. They take excellent care using pet care professional while they maintain strict guidelines assuring the safety of your pet. Normal shipping time length are between 12-24 hours depending on flight and distance, Flights are booked in advance with arrival times and confirmation number Delta has climate control facilities wherever the puppies await flight. We want your shipping experience to be without difficulty and will do everything we can to assure you have a great experience when picking your puppy from the airport or when your baby is delivered to your home address. Delta courier agency offers both home delivery and delivery at the airport. (*For an additional cost) We do not like our puppies traveling in-cargo so the delivery agent will travel alongside with the puppy

After all balance have been paid, we call the airlines and book the flight. I will need to know your nearest 2 airports, who will pick up the pup and your address and 2 contact numbers, The day and time will depend primarily on the flight, availability, and temperature as well as when we both can travel to the airport usually. After I have booked the flight, I will email or call you with the flight times, airway bill and location where the puppy is to be picked up. Then all you need to do is pick the puppy at your airport.

Puppy Payments: All cost must be prepaid a day before we can ship puppy out. Form Of Payments Zelle, Venmo, Cash app, and Paypal.
